

## Extemporaneous Speaking Competition

Students will have the choice of speaking about a story depicted in a series of pictures or a single picture appropriate to their level of German. They may have a minute or two to look at the picture(s) and then approximately two minutes to talk about the picture(s) in German. Students at higher levels receive more complex pictures and should be prepared to give more detail in their speech. Judges rate the students as follows:

<b>Comprehensibility</b> <i>Overall, how well can the student be understood (pronunciation, vocabulary, etc.)?</i>	<b>Oral Grammar</b> <i>Does the student exhibit level-appropriate control of grammar?</i>	<b>Creativity</b> <i>How creative is the student's story about the picture(s)?</i>	<b>Details</b> <i>How detailed is the student's story about the picture(s)?</i>	<b>Total</b> <b>(20)</b>
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
